



# Annual Budget Vote and Board Election Tuesday, May 17, 2022 ELECTION INFORMATION

## VOTER ELIGIBILITY

To be qualified to vote in a District election, you must be:

- \* at least 18 years of age;
- \* a legal resident of the school district for at least 30 days prior to the vote;
- \* a citizen of the United States

In addition, you may not be otherwise prohibited from voting under the provisions of Election Law § 5-106.

## VOTING LOCATION, DATE & TIME

Voting will take place on May 17, 2022 in the East Aurora Middle School Cafeteria, 430 Main Street, East Aurora from 7:00 AM until 9:00 PM. Parking will be available in the Parking Lot behind the Middle School on North Grove Street.

Voters will be asked to cast a ballot regarding the following:

### PROPOSITION NO. 1 – BUDGET

Shall the following resolution be adopted?

RESOLVED, that the budget for the East Aurora Union Free School District, Erie County, New York (the “District”), for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023, as presented by the Board of Education of the District in the amount of \$41,296,498 is hereby approved and adopted, and the required funds therefor are hereby appropriated, and the necessary real property taxes required shall be levied on the taxable property in the District to be collected as required by law.

### PROPOSITION NO. 2 – FUNDING OF REPAIR RESERVE

Shall the following resolution be adopted?

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Aurora Union Free School District, Erie County, New York (the “District”) is hereby authorized to transfer \$500,000 from the unrestricted fund balance of the District to the District’s Repair Reserve Fund which is operated (pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 6-d) for the purpose of paying for the cost of non-recurring future repairs to District capital improvements and equipment.

### ELECTION OF THREE AT-LARGE BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBERS

Voters will be voting for three candidates. The candidates receiving the two highest vote totals shall each be elected to three-year terms, commencing July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2025, to fill the vacancies created by the expiration, on June 30, 2022, of the terms of Terri Ohlweiler and Judith Malys. The candidate who receives the third-highest number of votes will be elected to complete the remainder of John Sigeti’s original term, commencing immediately upon the filing of such candidate’s oath of office and expiring on June 30, 2023.
