## Grading Policy:

Your grade is based on Total Points and will be broken down as follows per marking period:

Homework	20 points per week
Drills	5-10 points each 1-2 collected per week
Quizzes	20 points each (approximately 1 per week)
Essay/DBQs	100 points each
Tests	100 points in class or on Castle Learning
Worksheets/Classwork	as necessary

- Homework is to be completed each night it is assigned. It is worth a total of 20 points per week. **I do not accept late homework or late work.**
- Drills are to be completed every class. I will collect and grade 1-2 drills each week. The drills are worth 5 points each (5-10 points per week). You will have 5 minutes in the beginning of each class to complete the drill. If you are absent you are excused from that day's drill.
- Quizzes will be both announced and unannounced.
- Essay/DBQs are a very important part of the Regents Exam. They may be assigned for homework or in class. Generally you will get 1 essay and/or 1 DBQ a marking period.
- Tests are an assessment of what you have achieved in each unit. All tests will be announced. See also Castle Learning below.

## Castle Learning

-Some assignments may be on Castle Learning. You will be notified in advance regarding these assignments. **If you do not complete them you will receive no credit.**

-These assignments will be give 4-5 days to complete.

-You will need to have your login & password. I do not have them, you must contact the office.

- If you do not have Internet access at home, there are plenty available at school. You may use the Media Center or even my Pod during studyhalls, activity period or after-school to complete.

## Absences:

\*It is your responsibility to see me **Activity Period** to get the work you missed the day return. This will be located in the MAKE-UP WORK binder. You may also email by 3pm to find out what you missed. You must also see me during the activity period when you return to turn in work that was due when you were absent.

\* This is also the time to show me homework that was due while you were absent.

\* If you have questions ask me for clarification.

\*If you have a music lesson you *must* see me the **Activity Period** *prior* to your lesson to show me your homework and to get that day's work.

\*You get as many days to make up the work as you were absent.

\*If you are absent the day of a quiz you will take it the *next day*.

\*If you are absent the day of a test you will take it the *next day*.

It is your responsibility to be ready to take the missed assessments the day you return!
